Miami Visitor Day Planner

Use the row that sounds most like the day in front of you. The goal is not maximum coverage. It is a cleaner first decision.

CHOICE	USE IT WHEN...
Miami Beach	Ocean, palms, Art Deco, and the fastest iconic visitor signal.
Little Havana	A focused food-and-culture lane with strong Miami identity.
Wynwood / Midtown	Murals, food, browsing, and a more social city feel.
Brickell / Downtown	Skyline, bayfront access, dining, and urban tempo.

ONE RULE THAT SAVES THE PLAN

Choose signal over coverage. One complete lane is better than a Miami sampler with tired people.

Before You Go

CHECK THESE FIRST

- ☐ Ask what kind of Miami the visitors actually want.
- ☐ Pick one district or coastal lane.
- ☐ Add one meal or one short support move.
- ☐ Keep weather and walking tolerance honest.
- ☐ Stop before the plan becomes a proof-of-Miami exercise.

IF THE DAY SHIFTS

If the group loses energy, keep the strongest signal and cut the secondary stop.

FAST EXIT CUE

If the optional part starts to feel like obligation, cut it before relocating the whole outing.
